Eligibility Criteria and Scholarships

1 Eligibility

An applicant holding foreign citizenship whose parents are also foreign citizens (not Korean citizens) is eligible to apply as an international student. Korean citizens who hold dual citizenship are not eligible to apply.

2 Language Requirements and Scholarships for New Students

- Applicants must meet one of the language requirements below for admission.
- Scholarships will be provided based on the applicant's proficiency in the Korean language.
